

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Welcome back after the Easter holidays.

I can't believe that we are already in the Summer term! We can promise that the new term will bring lots more fun and exciting activities and learning opportunities. Our new topic is called 'New Life' and focuses on the magical changes that we notice as we move into Spring.



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Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will discuss what we need to do to care for our environment focusing on plants, birds and mini-beasts in our school and home environment.

Literacy

We will read a selections of stories linked to our topic including Farmer Duck, The Hungry Caterpillar, Jaspers Beanstalk. We will make our own books using a variety of materials to draw. We will share our work , giving meaning to our marks.

In Phonics, we will continue to explore rhyme and learn nursery rhymes making silly songs. We will also be beginning our jolly phonics. We will be starting with long consonants matching them to the grapheme 's, 1, f, z, w, r, v, n, m' and spotting objects that start with these sounds.

Understanding of the world

We will focus on signs of spring and how the seasons are changing. We will care for and grow plants in and outside our class.

We will design and make a minibeast. We will continue to mix colours using a variety of materials to print and paint patterns.

We will be listening for sounds of spring, using instruments to create familiar sounds.
