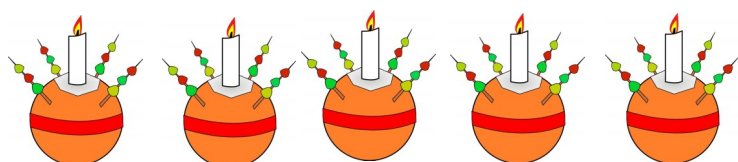
A chance for an early Christmas present
