



Welcome back after the half-term break.

Our main topic this half-term is called 'I'll Huff and I'll Puff' based around the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'. In English we will explore the Narrative form of story-writing, focusing on characters, story structure and drama with a special emphasis on composition and effect.



- In Maths we will be following the National Curriculum, and where appropriate will link this with our topic. This half term we will particularly focus on measure and continue to work on place value within 50 and count with multiples of 2, 5 and 10.

As well as our main topic we will also cover these areas:

- In PE we will be covering games and dance.
*Owls PE lessons will be on a **Tuesday morning and a Friday afternoon**. Please ensure your child has appropriate kit including a warm track suit, trainers or plimsolls. It really helps us if, on PE days, long hair is tied back and if earrings are taken out before coming to school.*
- In DT we will create a moving scene, using joins and mechanisms. We would appreciate it if you could bring in boxes of various sizes.
- In Geography we will look at homes focusing on villages, towns and cities.
- In Music we will be exploring musical symbols and creating sound effects using tuned and untuned percussion instruments.
- In Science, we will learn about grouping and changing materials. The children will be looking at the effect that heating and cooling can have on different materials.
- In PSHCE we will focus on 'Good to be me'.
- In RE we will revisit who is a Christian and focus on the Christian celebration of Easter.

Mrs Parkin will be teaching music and science on Thursday afternoons.

This half-term's value is forgiveness.

There will be a 'Drop in session' every other Wednesday (see newsletters for further information) from 3:00pm until 3:15pm whilst the children are in assembly. This is a time for you to catch us, look at your child's work or discuss any minor concerns.
