



Welcome back after the half term break. Our new topic is called 'New Life' and focuses on the magical changes that we notice as we move into Spring.



Literacy

We will continue to explore and read a range of stories to help develop their language. We will tell stories and we will be scribing them together. We will also be acting our stories out as a class.

In Phonics, we will continue to look at compound and 2 syllable words.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development We will focus on our values forgiveness; being sensitive to others needs. We will continue to play co-operatively considering each other ideas of how to oragnise an activity.

Understanding of the world

We will focus on changes in our outside environment, particularly observing plants and animals. The children will consider how to care for the world understanding their responsibilities. We celebrate Easter discussing customs and tradition exploring how other communities celebrate during this special festival.





Construction and Expressive Art & Design In our construction area we will use a variety of materials and processes to create our ideas.

Maths

We will continue to look at the number system from 1 to 5 and this time we will explore different ways to make numbers using our fingers and other recourses. We will also encourage the children to contribute to our number board each week. Please continue to encourage your child to explore the number of the week in their environment; spotting the numeral, looking at coins and counting objects and actions accurately.

Physical Development

We will be focusing on dance and movement. We will explore different travels to represent minibeasts. PE is on a Tuesday morning or Wednesday afternoon but please could your child have their PE kit in school daily. A reminder that kit needs to contain; shorts, coloured team t-shirt, and all clothes must be labelled with their names. Earrings should not be worn on PE days and long hair needs to be tied back.
