Thank you to everyone for helping to make drop off in the morning run smoothly. Please remember that you need to queue and distance. When picking up at the end of the day either at the gate or on the playground please collect your child and leave immediately. Children must not run around the playground.

Although we are not able to have a drop in for the foreseeable future, please be assured that we are still keen to keep the gateway to communication between school and home very much open.

You are very welcome to e-mail any concerns to school, and these will be passed on to the class teachers. They will contact you by phone or by e-mail as soon as they are able to.
