English

This half term we will be working on

- Research skills and techniques
- Diary and Blog writing skills
- Newspapers and journalistic writing
- We will continue to develop proof reading and editing skills to revisit and improve all styles of writing
- We will also continue our work on:
 - * Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar
 - * Reading: Vocabulary, Inference, Prediction, Explanation, Retrieval and Summarising

Mathematics

This half term we will be focusing on the following areas of Maths:

- Percentages

- Measurement and Converting Units
- Area and Perimeter

Geography

This half term we will be concentrate on human geography, specifically economic activity and the impact of humans on the environment.

Science

This half term we will continue to explore classification, adaptation, natural selection and inheritance by:

- identifying how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways that adaptation may lead to evolution
- giving reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics

Computing

We will learn what a text adventure is, plan and make a story-based adventure and then add coding to our map-based adventures.

RE

This term, Year 6 will be looking at Christian Salvation, where we will be working on answering the question 'What difference does the Resurrection make to Christians?'

Other subjects

Art: We will take inspiration from the Inuit's, and in particular, the work of Kenojuak Ashevakstyle, to make our own block prints with an Antarctic theme.

DT: We will design and make an environment for a small creature.

PSHE: We will be exploring gender neutrality, how this is represented in the media and shops, and how we can move forward with gender neutrality.
