**Thank you again for all of your support and hard work. We couldn't have done it without**

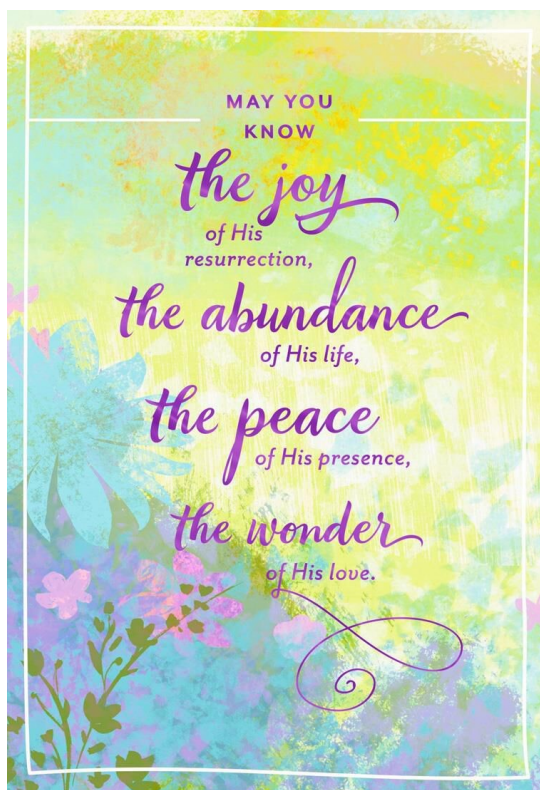
**We have had a lovely day today starting with our Easter celebration worship with Reverend Buckle.**
