### Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will be exploring our new environment establishing routines, rules and expectations. We will celebrate achievements school / home and during circle time linking them to our values.

We will discuss, plan and research things we would like to make/build. We will use blocks and recycled materials to construct these ideas. Please bring in any empty and clean yoghurts pots, collapsed boxes, tubes etc. to enhance our making area.

#### Maths

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We will continue to develop our number sense this half term working from 5-10. We will begin to use pennies at school to pay for items, like snacks. #### Literacy

We will continue to read a range of stories, developing language and awareness of structure. We will tell stories, scribing them together and acting them out as a class. In Phonics, we will continue to consolidate our retention of the initial sounds and use these to synthesise and read words. We will also begin to develop recognition and retention of key words. The children will receive reading books this half term please look after these bringing them to school daily and don't forget to celebrate their progress by writing regularly in the blue diary.
