<u>Literacy</u>

Phonics, we will recap digraphs (where 2 letters make 1 sound) and trigraphs (where 3 letters make 1 sound). We will synthesise and read words containing these sounds and use these sounds to segment words for spelling. We will also focus on key words and encourage the children to recognise and spell these words by sight.

We will focus on changes in our outside environment, particularly observing plants and animals. The children will consider how to care for the world understanding their responsibilities. Construction and Expressive Art & <u>Design</u>

In our construction area we will use a variety of materials and processes to create our ideas. We will focus on scissors skills holding them correctly and cutting accurately.

Maths

We will continue to develop our number knowledge working through the number system from 5—10. We will explore the composition of the numbers identifying all the number facts within the focus numeral. We will encourage the children to verbalise facts identifying patterns and explaining using mathematical language such as more, greater fewer, less, add, subtract etc. We will link our number of the week to 3d shapes identifying their 2d partner investigating their properties. (1, sphere and a circle) We will apply measurements in real life context paying for items, baking, constructing and timing events.

Physical Development

We will be focusing on dance and movement. We will explore different travels to represent minibeasts. PE is on a Friday morning but please could your child have their PE kit in school daily. A reminder that kit needs to contain; shorts, coloured team t-shirt, plimsoles/trainers and all clothes must be labelled with their names. Earrings should not be worn on PE days and long hair needs to be tied back.
