Our topic focus this half-term is called 'We're All Going on a Summer Holiday'. We will focus on the British seaside and the children will have the opportunity to share their experiences. Please send in pictures or postcards of places you have been on holiday.

Our holiday topic will cover the following curriculum areas:

- In PE we will cover games and cricket.
Owls PE lessons will be on a Tuesday afternoon and a Friday afternoon. Please ensure your child has appropriate kit including a warm track suit, trainers or plimsolls. It really helps us if, on PE days, long hair is tied back and if earrings are taken out before coming to school.
- In geography we will be learning about the seas that surround the British Isles and focus on coastal features.
- In history the children will learn about Victorian seaside holidays comparing these to seaside holidays of today.
We will also look at Queen Victoria as a significant individual in history.
- In RE we will study places of worship.
- In science we will be learning about animals and their habitats.
- PSHCE will focus on changes - linking to transition to new classes.
- In Maths we will be working on place value within a 100, geometry and time.
- In Literacy we will be writing poems, postcards and recounting a sea side holiday.
