



### Tower of London



To build on the Year 6 History theme 'The History of Crime and Punishment', we would like to offer your child the opportunity to visit The Tower of London. Although the Tower of London was not built as a prison, it has, over the centuries acquired a fearsome reputation as one of England's most notorious prisons.

The children will attend the following session, led by Tower staff (staff will remain with the children at all times):

**Crime and punishment through the ages** – pupils will put themselves in the shoes of a prisoner. Where would they have been locked up? What was the Tower like for a prisoner? What crime might they have committed? Children will hear exciting stories of the Tower's dark history and explore some of the historic spaces used to hold prisoners.
