The Parent Forum had their first **Feedback Friday** on 4th October and I am pleased to say that we had a very good response.

A very big thank you to all of you who completed our survey either online or as a paper copy. The majority of you chose the online survey monkey option, we had 40 responses via this method, and 7 of you chose to share your views using a paper copy. Our Survey Monkey can even tell us that the average time spent completing the questionnaire was just 1 min 4 seconds, so it really doesn't take long to have your opinion counted.
