The staff members at Great Barford Primary Academy are here to educate your children and to ensure that they are safe and have the best quality education possible. Your children and their education must come first. The children should not be witness to or be involved in adult disputes,

Staff members at the school are not qualified to deal with parental disputes or antisocial behaviour. The school has a zero tolerance policy towards this behaviour and will call upon the assistance of other agencies to deal with this if necessary.

I hope that this makes the schools position clear to all. Thank you for the support of all those parents who have raised their concerns about these incidences and the impact that they have had.
