Dear Parents and Carers,

The Parent Forum had their second meeting last month. Our remit is to collect views, suggestions and solutions from the wider parent group in order to support the school in moving forward.

The aim of the last meeting was to discuss the issue of communication within our school. This was an issue that many of you felt strongly about when completing the OFSTED Parent View Survey. We chose to address this area first as we believe that communication plays a crucial part in how we feel involved and engaged with our children's school life and learning.

Considering that this was an area that many of parents and carers had strong views on in the OFSTED survey, we were disappointed to receive only 3 email responses. Thank you to those parents who took the time to give their thoughts and ideas.

We think it is important to say at this point that communication is a 2-way process. If we are to deliver your messages to the school so that they can create the effective lines of communication that you feel are lacking, we need to know what the problem areas are.

Our meeting focused on the following key areas that were raised by our responders:


