

Tin Foil Sea Monster

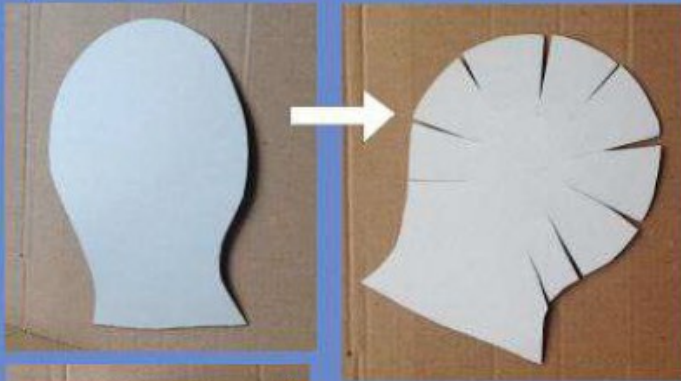

... instructions on next photo

1 - Cut out a thin card shape, about the size of your palm, and cut slits in it like this . . .



2 - Pull this shape together to make it 3D.



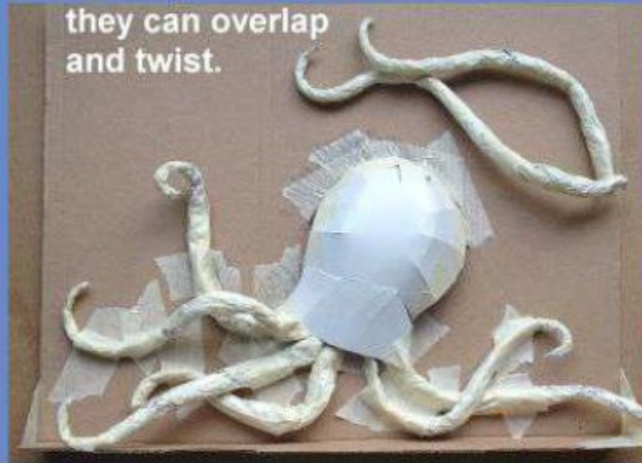
3 - Roll up some tin foil for legs.



4 - Attach the body to a base, leave the bottom side open to fit the legs into.
* Fold a narrow shelf up at the bottom of the base . . .



5 - Keep adding the tentacles . . . they can overlap and twist.



6 - Roll up two balls of foil for the eyes and two sausage shapes for eyebrows and attach them to the head . . .



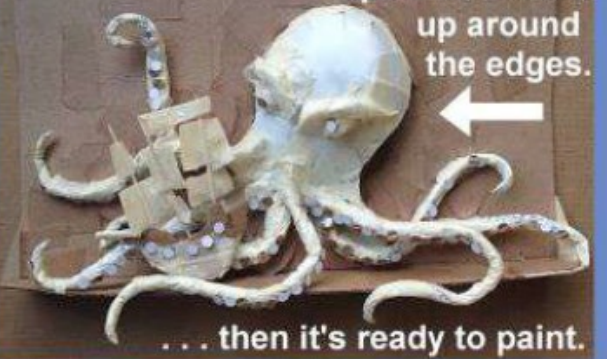
7 - You could make a little ship? I've used a piece of card for the hull, cocktail sticks for masts and simply tape for the sails.



8 - You could use a 'hole punch' to add some 'suckers' or, if you haven't got one, glue on some rice or lentils?



9 - Use ripped up card to hide any tape that shows up around the edges.



. . . then it's ready to paint.
