<u>Personal, Social &</u> <u>Emotional Development</u> We will be settling in our new class and becoming secure in the routines. There will be lots of opportunities to play group games developing relationships with our class mates and teachers. We will explore our own feelings and reflect upon people who are special to us.

<u>Construction and Expressive Art & Design</u> We will use a variety of materials to make self portraits and family images. We will use a range of constructions kits and recyclable materials to build homes for the small world people.

We will discuss and share our favourite things e.g books and toys. Our class books will include the Mr Men series. We will create our own characters and describe their looks and personality.
