Literacy

- Reading and retelling traditional tales of The Three Little Pigs and The Three Billy Goats Gruff.
- Using different materials to mark make, whilst explaining what we have drawn.



- Practicing counting a set of objects accurately. Developing our understanding that lining objects up helps us.
- Exploring distance and capacity outside using cars, water and mud.



Communication and <u>Language</u>

- Taking care to listen carefully to sounds in our environment and to follow 2 step instructions accurately.
 - Singing nursery rhymes and playing memory games.

Expressive Art and Design

- Locating and selecting resources to support our play.
- Working with our friends to narrate stories, explore movement and sing songs.
- Setting up a cafe in the home corner.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Sharing and turn taking whilst understanding the importance of using our words to communicate our feelings.
- Telling others to "stop! I don't like that", if things are upsetting us.
- Seeking help from familiar adults when needed.



Physical Development

- Developing our independence when dressing ourselves for outside.
- Organising and arranging equipment we need, such as for painting.
- Practicing our cutting skills and understand the importance of
