Friends of Great Barford Primary Academy Online Payment via Bank Transfer

Dear Parents and Carers,

We have introduced an online payment option, and we need to be able to distinguish which child a payment is for.

When paying by bank transfer please use the child's surname and class year as a reference. When paying for siblings to attend the same event, again use their surname and put both class years.

For example,

SMITH 4 This shows the surname, and year four

SMITH R 5 This shows the surname, and reception and year five.
