


Ducklings

Literacy

We are still enjoying making our stories, scribing them together and acting our stories out as a class.

Maths

We are still looking at the number system from 3 to 5 and we will continue to explore different ways to make numbers using our fingers and other recourses. We will also encourage the children to contribute to our number board each week. Please continue to encourage your child to explore the number of the week in their environment; spotting the numeral, looking at coins and counting objects and actions accurately.

Physical Development

This half term we will be using equipment outside. We will be using balls to dribble and kick, quoits to help with balance and rackets and balls to help with hand to eye coordination. PE is on a Tuesday morning or Wednesday afternoon so please could your child have their PE kit in school daily. A reminder that kit needs to contain; shorts, coloured team t-shirt, and all clothes must be labelled with their names. Earrings should not be worn on PE days
