Science: The focus for this half term is: habitats and animals and living things.

To define the term 'habitat', giving examples and animals that live in each place.

- Choose a few different habitats, watch the video and complete the quiz and activities at the bottom of the page.

ICT: The focus this half term is: creating presentations.

To explore how a story can be presented in different ways.

- Read the story 'The Three Bears' (see PowerPoint story in ICT folder).
- Have you got this story at home? Can you compare the story to this one?
- Discuss the story and how it has been presented (small piece of text followed by a picture).
- Open 'Three Bears Quiz' which is set as a To Do on Purple Mash.

• Once you have had a good go at this, have a brief discussion about the different types of questions in the quiz and any difficulties that you had with it (with an adult). This will prepare you for making a quiz next week.

Topic: Geography The focus this half term is: geographical features of the seaside.

<u>To use geographical vocabulary to name features of familiar and unfamiliar places.</u>

Using the 'features of a seaside' power point work your way through the questions in it and do the activities on it (in geography folder).

Make a 3-D model to show the seaside features using sand, shingle, mud, rocks, gravel and other natural materials that you can find.

Add labels to the different features.

Coastal features **could** include: beach, stack, arch, cove, cave, cliff and island.
